### New Business

- CCSD PreK-12 Code of Conduct: The Code of Conduct can be found on CCSD website and James I Gibson website. James I Gibson website - Family Information - Important Docs. The Code of Conduct is a document of infractions and the suggested course of actions. It has a list of all infractions that can get a student sent to the office. It will list if it is Minor, Major or Urgent and the required action to take. If it is a phone call to the parent, an in person meeting, in house suspension, at home suspension or explosion. Some schools have the Star On program which takes place of behavior schools. It will also list if Law Enforcement needs to be notified and/or restitution. It is used to ensure consistency across CCSD schools. Administrators will also look at past infractions the student has made as well to determine how the situation needs to be handled. Due to FERPA Law, if your child is involved in a situation with another student, the administration will not be able to tell you anything about the other student.
  - A question was asked if the administration felt they had enough tools and support to handle behavior problems in the school. The admin feels that a positive space has been created within the school where they are able to handle situations at

the school level. They also feel they have the backing and support of the region and district.

- Summer Acceleration: Summer Acceleration is different from ESY (Extended School Year). ESY helps older students who need to get their credits and special ed students to help prevent the “summer slide”. Summer Acceleration is funded from a grant given to the school born from the COVID shut down. It is a free program for students. It focuses on academic skills and enrichment. It lasts 3 weeks in June. Anyone can sign up. You are no longer able to sign up using the Google Form. If you are interested in signing up, please contact the school and they can help you. Around 100 students have signed up so far. More information will be sent home at the end of April/early May along with the class assignments.
