



Arrival and Dismissal at Gibson

Arrival:

Parents must check their child(ren) for the following each morning prior to sending your student to school. If your student shows any signs indicated below, keep the student home and contact your medical provider for guidance.

Cough, Chills, Sore Throat, Muscle Pain, Fever 100° or Higher, Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing, New Loss of Taste or Smell, Congestion, Fatigue, Headache, Runny Nose, Nausea/Vomiting, Diarrhea

If your student is not feeling well or has any symptoms of COVID-19, has been exposed to someone with COVID-19, or tested positive with COVID-19 (provide a copy of test results to the health office), they must stay home from school. Notify the School Nurse if any of these occur.

Parents will drop their children off at one of our gates - Kindergarten, Silver Springs Park (if it's open), Bike Rack - between 7:40 and 7:53 a.m. At 7:53, a whistle will blow to indicate it is time for students to line up on their dots. Duty personnel will lock the gates and parents will need to walk their child to the front office to be checked in after the whistle blows.

No parents will be invited on the blacktop. All parents will need to check in at the front office to enter the building.

Dismissal:

Dismissal will be arranged, as determined, by each classroom teacher. Teachers will let parents know that students will be dismissed AFTER the bell at 2:11 p.m. and it can take a few minutes to get to the dismissal location. Children that are not picked up by 2:20 will be walked to the office for parents to pick them up. Habitual late pick ups will be cause to place students in Safekey which incurs a cost to the family.
